
TH

TH test For fresh and salt water

- 1 Fill the tube up to the mark with the test water.
- Slowly allow the indicator solution to drop in with continual swivelling.
- 3 Count the drops until the colour change from pink to blue is complete.



Calculation:

Indicator drops x 0.5 = TH (°dH) A drop of indicator solution equals 0.5°dH.

Evaluation:

- If the determined value is 5°dH or more, the total hardness is sufficient.
- If the value is below 5°dH the total hardness is too low.
